



- Grain Valley Newspaper
  - Ocity Administrator Ryan Hunt explained that he was recently approached by Penny Kruse about opportunities to help the community since the local newspaper ceased. She has been working on a business plan to start a City newspaper and after discussions, Hunt believes this could be treated as an incubator project. The City could provide space, surplus equipment, and software in exchange for in-kind advertising. He noted that the "Gardner's House" at the Ponderosa will provide adequate space for the start-up and Wi-Fi access will be available. The newspaper could be used for public notices, which can be very costly.

Mrs. Kruse shared that she has approached local businesses about supporting a local newspaper and has had favorable responses. She would like to publish a weekly paper – either on Wednesday or Saturday and would like to have the first issue published by the first week in November.

Board members agreed to move forward on the project. City Administrator Hunt will work with Mrs. Kruse to create a business plan and locate resources that the City can loan her for start-up. He will also discuss the plans with Rob Harrington of the EDC to see what support the EDC Board can provide.

#### ITEM XI: PRESENTATION

- Out of State Motor Vehicle Sales Tax Ballot Issue Ryan Hunt
  - City Administrator Hunt gave a short presentation on the August 2<sup>nd</sup> Out of State Motor Vehicle Sales Tax Election. He provided background information about the Missouri Supreme Court ruling in 2012 requiring cities to discontinue collecting local sales tax on out of state purchases unless voters vote against discontinuation of the tax. Grain Valley will lose approximately \$146,000 annually if the tax is discontinued. He explained that voting "no" allows the continued collection of existing sales taxes. Voting "yes" eliminates the tax and reduces revenues.
