



TYPICAL SECTION FRONT STREET STA. 0+00 TO STA. 15+00 NOT TO SCALE

- 6. The Contractor shall satisfy himself as to the accuracy of all measurements prior to construction of any permanent structure.
- 7. The contractor shall notify the City of Grain Valley Engineering Services Department forty-eight (48) hours prior to beginning construction.


