

The Grain Valley Parks and Recreation Department in accordance with the Jackson County Stay-At-Home Executive Order have closed all park playgrounds, picnic shelters and restrooms to the general public effective March 24, 2020. However, our parks including trails and open greenspace will remain open and available for patrons to utilize. We want to make sure that during this challenging time, there are still outdoor opportunities available for your physical and mental well-being.

While visiting our parks, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines issued by the CDC and our local health officials in response to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- Do not use parks or trails if you are exhibiting symptoms.
- Follow CDC's guidance on personal hygiene prior to visiting parks or trails.
- Observe CDC's minimum recommended social distancing of 6' from other patrons at all times.
- Share the trail and warn other trail users of your presence and as you pass.
- Be prepared for no access to public restrooms or water fountains.

If you visit our parks, please do not use the playgrounds, picnic shelters or any other park amenity that people commonly touch by hand.
